The Cursillo Weekend



It begins on a Thursday evening and ends with a closing Eucharist the following Sunday afternoon.



You will hear talks and meditations on the Christian life, which will often lead to lively follow-up discussions.



During the three days, those participating in the Cursillo and those organising the Weekend live, work and worship together.



This is not a silent retreat although there is time for reflection and quiet time built into the weekend.
